AN ACT AMEND §19103 OF 17G.C.A. RELATIVE TO  
ALLOWING STUDENTS POSSESSING A BACHELORS  
DEGREE IN A SUBJECT OTHER THAN NURSING TO  
QUALIFY FOR THE NURSING TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP.

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.** §19103 of 17G.C.A is hereby *amended* to read:

3           **§19103. Selection of Trainees.** The program shall be open to any student who  
4 has completed high school, or is otherwise declared by the University of Guam as  
5 eligible for admission to the program; who is a United States citizen or permanent  
6 resident alien; *and* who has been a resident of Guam for *at least* one (1) year *prior to*  
7 the beginning of the academic semester or term the student is admitted, registered and  
8 enrolled in the program. The number of trainees who may enroll in the program  
9 annually shall be limited *only* by the capacity of the University of Guam and by funds  
10 made available to it by annual appropriation. In the event of limited space and/or funds,  
11 priority shall be given to students at the highest level of training and closest to the  
12 completion of their program. No student may receive stipends beyond the number of  
13 calendar years normally required to complete a training program. Notwithstanding any  
14 other provision of law or administrative rules and regulations, students who hold a  
15 bachelors degree in a subject other than nursing shall be eligible for the program herein  
16 provided that such students meet all other requirements herein.
