AN ACT TO ALLOW THE VOTERS OF GUAM TO
DETERMINE WHETHER MR. JUAN FLORES
SHOULD BE RETAINED AS SUPERINTENDENT OF
SCHOOLS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Election.** The measure below shall be placed before the
3 voters of Guam at the next general election and whether or not other
4 issues are also on the same ballot or otherwise before the voters.

5 **Section 2. Placement on ballot.** The measure placed on the ballot
6 pursuant to this act shall be treated in the same fashion as measures are
7 placed on the ballot concerning the retention of judges in Guam. Should
8 a simple majority of voters who are voting on the measure vote "yes" on
9 the measure, such vote will be interpreted as voter approval of the
10 continuance of Mr. Juan Flores as Superintendent of Schools. Should a
11 simple majority of voters who are voting on the measure vote "no" on
12 the measure, such vote will be interpreted as voter rejection of the
13 continuance of Mr. Juan Flores as Superintendent of Schools. Section 3
14 of this act contains the language to be submitted.

15 **Section 3. Language to be placed on ballot.** The following specific
16 language shall be placed on the ballot:

1 **"QUESTION ON THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**

2 **Shall Mr. Juan Flores be retained in office as Superintendent of**
3 **Schools for the Guam Public School System?**

4 **VOTE "YES" OR "NO".**"

5 **Section 4.** Following the language on the ballot described in Section
6 Three of this act, the Guam Election Commission shall cause to be
7 placed two ovals, one marked "yes" and one marked "no".

8 **Section 5.** Should a simple majority of voters who vote on this measure
9 vote "yes", Mr. Juan Flores shall be retained as Superintendent of
10 Schools for the Guam Public School System, under terms and conditions
11 identical to his existing contract, for a period of four (4) years, such
12 period commencing on January 1, 2007.

13 **Section 6.** Should a simple majority of voters who vote on this measure
14 vote "no", Mr. Juan Flores shall not be retained as Superintendent of
15 Schools for the Guam Public School System and his contract with the
16 Guam Public School System shall terminate on December 31, 2006.

17 **Section 7.** Notwithstanding any action of the Guam Education Policy
18 Board, the current employment contract for Mr. Juan Flores as
19 Superintendent of Schools for the Guam Public School System shall
20 remain in effect until the close of business on December 31, 2006.
