AN ACT TO INCREASE ACCESS TO MEDICAL CARE BY LIMITING AWARDS IN CASES OF MEDICAL LIABILITY BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 10104 TO TITLE 7 G.C.A.

1 BE IT ENACED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 10104 is added to Title 7 of the Guam Code
Annotated to read as follows:

"§10104. Caps on Damages. In action for damages against any 4 physician arising out of the provision of or failure to provide health 5 care services, the physician shall not be liable for more than \$100,000 6 in any action for wrongful death, no more than Three Hundred 7 Thousand Dollars \$300,000 in any other tort action, including but not 8 limited to personal injury. A single cap applies regardless of the 9 number of defendants or other health care providers against whom 10 the claim is asserted or the number of separate causes of action upon 11 which the claim is based. All persons claiming to have sustained 12 damages as the result of the bodily injury or death of a single person 13 shall be considered a single plaintiff for purposes of this section." 14

Section 2. If any provision of this Act is held by a court to be invalid
 or unenforceable for any reason, no other provision of law shall be affected
 thereby, and to this end the provisions of this Act are hereby declared
 severable.
