AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$75,000) FROM THE BUFFER STRIP REVOLVING FUND OF THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, OF FOR THE SOLE **PURPOSE** CONDUCTING FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE USAGE OF LOT NO. 10155-2 AS A LOCATION FOR THE NEW FLEA MARKET AND FARMERS MARKET, AND FOR THE ARCHITECTURAL **DESIGN** AND **ENGINEERING PLANS** OF THESE PROPOSED NEW FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- that there has been and continues to be a genuine need for the construction of
- 3 a Farmers Market in the municipality of Dededo for the many farmers and
- 4 cottage industry vendors to sell their agricultural products at a centralized
- 5 location. This centralized location must be easily accessible, clean, sanitary,

and spacious, and above all, must have rental fee charges that are nominal and affordable to the utilizing public as a whole.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that such facility can be a positive stimulus to the farmers and cottage industry vendors to maximize their production because of the accessibility of facilitated centralized outlet.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds that the Office of the Public Auditor through their Review of Dormant and Inactive Accounts in the Government of Guam, dated April 2006, and which was mandated by Public Law 28-68, has identified unexpended balance of \$154,917 in the Dededo Buffer Strip Revolving Fund, which was authorized and established by Public Law 24-59. The Public Auditor has recommended this account for closure and its accumulated and forthcoming revenues be directly transmitted to the General Fund.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan believes that a portion of these monies in the Dededo Buffer Strip Revolving Fund can be put to a very good usage by utilizing it as a source of funding for architectural and engineering design of the proposed new Dededo Flea Market and Farmers Market.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to reappropriate Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) from the Dededo Buffer Strip Revolving Fund established by §68901(c) of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated (Public Law 24-59), to the Department of Public Works for feasibility assessment and architectural and engineering design of the proposed Flea Market and Farmers Market in Dededo.

- Section 2. Appropriation for architectural and engineering design.
- 2 The sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) is hereby
- 3 reappropriated from the Buffer Strip Revolving Fund of the Mayor's Office of
- 4 the municipality of Dededo to the Department of Public Works for the
- 5 feasibility assessment and architectural design of the proposed new Dededo
- 6 Flea Market and Farmers Market to be constructed at 6.9994 acres of Lot No.
- 7 10155-2, municipality of Dededo.
- 8 Section 3. Architectural and engineering design. The Department of
- 9 Public Works shall prepare necessary architectural and engineering design of
- 10 the proposed new Farmers Market and Flea Market, to be located at the
- 6.9994 acres of Lot No. 10155-2, municipality of Dededo. These proposed
- designs should be coordinated very closely with the Mayor and Vice Mayor
- of Dededo, the Dededo Municipal Planning Council, and the Farmers'
- 14 Association in the northern districts of Guam.
- Section 4. The Department of Public Works and the Mayor's Office of
- Dededo shall conduct a joint public hearing on the proposed designs for the
- 17 purpose of soliciting suggestions and input from the residents of Dededo and
- 18 Yigo.
