**AN TO AMEND ITEM (d) OF §3101 OF TITLE 16, GUAM  
CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE USE  
OF OUT-OF GUAM DRIVER'S LICENSES UP TO A PERIOD  
OF ONE YEAR.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Item (d) of Section 3101 of Title 16, Guam Code Annotated is  
3 hereby *amended* read:

4 (d) A person having in his immediate possession a valid operator's license or  
5 chauffeur's license issued by any other territory, Commonwealth, or state of the United  
6 States, or approved foreign country may drive a motor vehicle upon the roads and  
7 highways for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days from the date such person arrived  
8 on Guam. However, upon the expiration of such thirty (30) day period, such person  
9 must have been issued ~~apply for~~ a Guam driver's license in order to continue driving on  
10 Guam. Such person, ~~and~~ shall be exempted from taking the written driver's license  
11 examination. Upon issuance of the Guam driver's license, such person shall surrender  
12 the driver's license previously issued by the other United States jurisdiction or approved  
13 foreign country, to the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Revenue and  
14 Taxation, unless the Director of Revenue and Taxation has adopted other procedures  
15 for the disposition of the previously issued license from the other United States  
16 jurisdiction or approved foreign country.

1        The thirty (30) period herein may be extended for a period equal to the earlier of  
2 one (1) year from the date the licensee arrived on Guam or the expiration date of the  
3 out-of-Guam license, provided that the licensee (1) registers his or her license with the  
4 Department Of Revenue And Taxation, and (2) pays a registration fee to the Treasurer  
5 of Guam not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25). Upon approval of registration, the  
6 Department Of Revenue And Taxation shall issue a Certificate of Registration that  
7 states (1) the name and age of the licensee, (2) the expiration of the certificate and the  
8 (3) the licensee's out-of Guam driver's licensee number.

9        The Department of Revenue and Taxation may withhold or delay registration of  
10 an out-of-Guam license if (1) The Department of Revenue and Taxation can not verify  
11 or has cause to doubt the validity of such out-of-Guam license (2) the licensee is unable  
12 to document the date of entry into Guam or (3) the authorization to use such out-of-  
13 Guam license has been revoked or suspended by the jurisdiction issuing such license.  
14 The Department of Revenue and Taxation may require a prospective registrant to  
15 validate his or her license through passage of a written exam, road test or both.
