AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE NEED TO RE-OPEN PROBATES OF ESTATES OF DECEASED GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREES IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PRIOR YEAR COST OF LIVING ALLOWANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Statement of Intent. The recent court ruling mandating the payment of prior year cost of living allowance payments to eligible retirees may result in a re-opening of the probates of estates for deceased retirees. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to reduce the need to incur the costs associated with such re-openings by authorizing the recognition of the "Administrators of Record" for completed probates as the persons to receive and distribute any payments of prior year cost of living allowances.

8 Section 2. Probate of Estates of Deceased Government of Guam Retirees waived. 9 For the purpose of prior year cost of living allowance payments only, an estate of a Government of 10 Guam retiree that has completed probate need not be re-opened for the receipt and distribution of 11 cost of living allowance payments resulting from Superior Court of Guam Case No. SP0206-93 . 12 Payments shall be issued to the "Estate of (name of decedent)", and receipt and distribution of 13 payments shall be made by the Administrator of Record for each estate.
