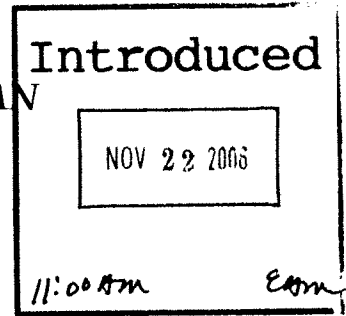

AN ACT TO AMEND ITEM 2 OF SUBSECTION (c) OF §15704.2, DIVISION 2 OF CHAPTER 15; TO AMEND §18105 OF ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 2 OF CHAPTER 18; TO ADD A NEW §15115 TO CHAPTER 15, ALL OF TITLE 22 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. **Licensing of Agents Amendment.** Item 2 of Subsection c
3 of §15704.2 of Article 7 of Chapter 15, Division 2 of Title 22 Guam Code
4 Annotated is amended to read:

5 “(2) accident and health, health maintenance organization or sickness-
6 insurance coverage for sickness, bodily injury or accidental death, and
7 may include benefits for disability income;”

8 Section 2. **Classes of Insurance Amendment.** Section 18105 of
9 Article 1, Division 2 of Chapter 18 of Title 22 Guam Code Annotated is
10 amended to read:

11 “§18105. **Accident, Sickness, Health, Health Maintenance**
12 **Organization, Property Damage and Liability Insurance.**

13 Accident insurance and sickness or health insurance includes

1 insurance against injury, disablement resulting from sickness, and
2 every insurance appertaining thereto. Property damage insurance
3 includes all types of insurance against loss or damage to property and
4 liability therefore. Liability insurance includes all insurance against
5 loss or damage resulting from accident to, or injury, fatal or non-fatal,
6 suffered by any person, and for which the insurer is liable."

7 **Section 3.** A new §15115 is hereby added to Chapter 15 of Title 22 of
8 the Guam Code Annotated to read:

9 **"§15115. Health Maintenance Organization (HMO).** An insurer
10 that is licensed to engage in the business of insurance on Guam providing
11 individual or group health care plans; or, health care services which an
12 enrolled population might reasonably require in order to be maintained in
13 good health, including, as a minimum, emergency care, inpatient hospital
14 and medical services, and outpatient medical services on a prepaid basis
15 and regulated under Guam law for solvency in such manner shall be issued
16 by the Commissioner a Health Maintenance Organization Certificate of
17 Authority."
