Section 2. Section 8141(b) of Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is to be amended as follows:

The Board of Trustees may employ an attorney to
assist and represent it in all civil matters, including civil
litigation matters, which concern the Board. The Board
of Trustees may set the terms and conditions of
employment for the attorney and his compensation.

The Attorney General shall represent the Board <u>in</u>
all criminal matters which concern the Board. in

1		litigation in which the Board is interested, provided that
2		the Attorney General shall designate the attorney for the
3		Board as a Special Assistant Attorney General for this
4		purpose.
5		The Board of Trustees may set the terms and
6		conditions of employment for the attorney and his
7		compensation.
8	Section 3.	Effective Date. The amendments herein shall be effective upon the
9	enactment.
