AN ACT TO AMEND §3108 OF CHAPTER 3, DIVISION 1, TITLE 19 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE HYPHENATION OF SURNAMES UPON MARRIAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan *Guåhan* to provide women and men with the option of hyphenating their
last names with the surnames of their spouses upon marriage.

5 Section 2. Amendment. §3108 of Chapter 3, Division 1, or Title 19 of

6 the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* as follows:

7	"§3108. A Woman May Elect to Retain Her Maiden Name <u>or</u>
8	Hyphenate Her Maiden Name With the Surname of Her Husband,
9	and A Man May Elect to Hyphenate His Surname With the Maiden
10	Name of His Wife Upon Marriage. Upon entering into a contract of
11	marriage a woman may elect to retain her maiden name <u>or</u>
12	hyphenate her maiden name with the surname of her husband as her

1	surname. Upon entering into a contract of marriage a man may elect
2	to hyphenate his surname with the maiden name of his wife as his
3	surname. Intention of the exercise of such an election shall be
4	indicated upon the marriage license application as provided for by
5	§3202 of this Title."
6	Section 3. Amendment. Item (7) of §3202 of Chapter 3, Division 1, of
7	Title 19 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended, a new Item (8) is
8	added, and the existing Item (8) is renumbered as follows:
