AN ACT TO AMEND § 3103 OF CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subitem (b) of §3103 of Chapter 3 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated

- "(b) Only the following constitute cause for the discharge of the Superintendent:
 - (1) holding financial interests that conflict with the conscientious performance of his duties;
 - (2) engaging in financial transactions using confidential or non-public GPSS information or allowing the improper use of such information to further any private interests;
 - (3) except as permitted by statute or regulation, the solicitation or acceptance of any item of value from any person or entity seeking official action from, doing business with, or conducting activities regulated by GPSS, or from persons whose interest may be substantially affected by the performance or nonperformance of the Superintendent's duties, or the duties of GPSS;
 - (4) knowingly making commitments or promises of any kind

1	purporting to bind GPSS except as permitted by law;
2	(5) use of his official position for his private gain or that of
3	others;
4	(6) failure to disclose waste, abuse and corruption to the
5	appropriate authorities;
6	(7) failure to respect the rights and privacy of others and the
7	use of his official position, authority or other means to injure
8	another person for personal reasons or malicious purposes;
9	(8) fraud or misrepresentation in securing his appointment;
10	(9) refusal or failure to perform duties and responsibilities as
11	defined by law;
12	(10) conviction of unlawful use, possession or sale of illicit
13	drugs and alcohol;
14	(11) conviction of criminal acts involving moral turpitude;
15	(12) political activity prohibited by law;
16	(13) conviction of misuse, misappropriation or theft of
17	government property or funds;
18	(14) prohibited acts of discrimination, including sexual
19	harassment; or
20	(15) abandonment of his position."
