AN ACT TO AMEND \$55102(d) OF CHAPTER 55, DIVISION 3, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION **OF** THE REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY **AND COMPENSATION ENFORCEMENT AND** BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. Public Law No. 28-154 established a 1 2 process for a comprehensive review of the compensation, benefits, position requirement, and duties of public safety and law enforcement officers of the government of Guam. The 3 end goal of the process is to make recommendations to I Liheslaturan Guåhan and to other 4 5 government officials that will address internal inequity and external competitiveness. Based on meetings and discussions already held by the Department of Administration, it is 6 7 revealed that the process is complex and complicate, involving twelve different disciplines, 8 with each discipline comprising of five to eight levels of grade or rank. The Department of Administration determined that due to these conditions, the deadline by which to submit 9 10 its final recommendations cannot be met. The Department of Administration accordingly requests, through written communication dated May 9, 2007, for an extension of time in order that it perform a comprehensive, thorough, and proper review and recommendation that Public Law 28-154 requires. It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend §55102(d) of Chapter 55, Division 3, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to extending the deadline for the submission of the review and recommendations for public safety and law enforcement compensation and benefits.

Section 2. §55102(d) of Chapter 55, Division 3, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

"(d) The Director of Administration shall commence said review upon enactment hereof and [one hundred eighty (180) days thereafter] no later than December 31, 2007 shall issue a final report that include recommendations of the Human Relations Officer Coordinating Council (HROCC) as established by Title 4 G.C.A., §4101.1(j), and stating his findings and recommendations. The Director shall provide the report to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the Judicial Council, Administrator of the Courts, Chief of Police, Fire Chief, Director of Corrections, Chief of Customs and Quarantine, Chief of Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority Police, Chief of Police of the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam, Director of Parks and Recreation and Director of Agriculture and shall post and notice the report in the manner prescribed in Title 4, G.C.A., Chapter 6, §6303.1(a)."
