AN ACT RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THAT ALL ADDITONAL FEES AND FUNDS GENERATED AS A RESULT OF THE ADJUSTMENT OR ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES AND PENALTIES THROUGH THE PASSAGE OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 29-02 BE DIRECTLY DEPOSITED INTO THEIR RESPECTIVE SPECIAL FUNDS AND APPROPRIATELY EXPENDED FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH THEREIN, TO COMMENCE OCTOBER 01, FISCAL YEAR 2008.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that in the deliberation of the revised fiscal 2 year 2007 budget contained in Public Law No. 29-02 it was necessary to 3 ensure that any additional revenues generated as a result of the adjusted or 4 newly established fees and penalties for numerous government services be 5 directly deposited into the General Fund of the Government of Guam to 6 continue the general operations of the entire government for the balance of 7 fiscal year 2007, in particular the agencies that provide direct service and 8 assistance in the areas of public safety, education and healthcare. 9 Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that these additional revenues generated 10

- through these specialized service fees and penalties should ultimately be
- 2 retained and deposited into the appropriate Special Fund to finance the
- 3 provision of services and activities as originally established for each of the
- 4 respective special fund or government service.
- Therefore, this provision would ensure that any funds generated as a
- 6 result of assessments, fees or penalties associated with a particular
- 7 government service be directly deposited to the applicable pre-existing
- 8 government special fund beginning with Fiscal Year 2008; thus said funds can
- 9 be utilized to further enhance the services being provided to the people of
- 10 Guam by the appropriate government agency. This allowance would be
- 11 applicable unless otherwise provided in law.
- Section 2. Commencing Fiscal Year 2008, Revenues Generated
- 13 through the Application of Specific Government Service Fees and Penalties
- shall be Retained and Deposited into their Respective Special Funds.
- Except as otherwise specifically established by law, all revenues
- resulting from adjusted *or* new fees adopted through the passage of Public
- 17 Law No. 29-02 shall be deposited into the respective government agency's
- 18 Special Fund, commencing with Fiscal Year 2008, and shall be expressly
- 19 utilized for the purposes as outlined within the requirements of the Special
- 20 Fund. The expenditure of any and all funds as highlighted herein shall be
- subject to appropriation and authorization by I Liheslaturan Guahan prior

- to such funds being expended, unless otherwise specifically provided in the
- 2 Special Fund's mandate.
