AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12803 (A) OF CHAPTER 12, TITLE 10 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AMENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE GUAM BOARD OF ALLIED HEALTH EXAMINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 12803 (a) of Chapter 12, Title 10 Guam Code
Annotated is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 12803. Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners. (a) Creation. There is established, in and for the government of Guam, a Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, composed of a representative from each of the profession being examined for licensure of which currently there are nine (9) members appointed by *I Maga'lahen Guahan*. *IMaga'lahen* Guahan shall appoint two (2) additional members, one (1) member for the Respiratory Therapist and one (1) member for the Nutritionist (Clinical Diatician, and shall appoint additional

member for the Nutritionist/Clinical Dietician, and shall appoint additional

members for other allied health profession being examined for licensure that

the Board includes in the its licensing procedure and specifically recommend 1 to I Maga'lahen Guahan to appoint a board member representative. There shall 2 be no Board member appointment with less than ten (10) allied health 3 professional qualified applicants for licensure within that allied health 4 profession of the applicants. The appointment of all current members of the 5 Board shall terminate on December 31, 2007. Appointments made to the Board 6 beginning on January 1, 2008 shall be for a term of three (years) with no Board 7 member serving more than one (1) consecutive term. The Board shall examine 8 applicants for licensure within the allied health professions not having 9 separate Board of Examiners enacted by I Liheslaturan Guahan." 10
