with the Organic Act of Guam. AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZATION AND

IMPLEMENTATION OF A THIRTY-FIVE (35) HOUR WORK-WEEK FOR GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan 2 Section 1.
- Guåhan finds that the government of Guam is experiencing a crisis in 3
- funding the operations of its government services. Immediate action
- is necessary in order to protect the general welfare and well-being of 5
- our Island. To do so, all three (3) branches of government must work 6
- together to reduce its cost of operations. Therefore, it is important
- that I Liheslaturan Guåhan enact and I Maga'lahen Guåhan implement 8
- legislation to facilitate the reduction of costs government-wide. 9

Accordingly, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, by enacting 1 this legislation, to authorize I Maga'lahen Guåhan to proceed with 2 necessary cost-cutting measures while protecting the education, 3 health, safety and welfare of our Island. By virtue of the passage of 4 this Act, I Mina' Bente Nuebe Na Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes the 5 need to provide ultimate authorities and flexibilities to I Maga'lahen 6 Guåhan to reduce the personnel expenditures of the government of 7 Guam and to ensure equity in treatment of all employees. 8 Recognizing the impracticability of modifying the merit system in 9 such emergent circumstances to deal with this crisis, passage of this 10 Act is necessary to provide I Maga'Lahen Guahan with the legal 11 authority for the full implementation of the reduced work-week of all 12 government of Guam employees from forty (40) hours to thirty-five 13 (35) hours with the exception of the most critical positions. 14 Maga'lahen Guåhan has concluded that it is impracticable to delay the 15 16 implementation of a reduced work-week, and intends to begin 17 furlough July 15, 2007, in order to avert payless paydays for

- 1 government employees. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that it is
- 2 impracticable not to permit such a reduction, as a matter of local
- 3 statutory law.
- 4 Section 2. Authorization to Reduce Work-Week Hours.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, I Maga'lahen Guåhan is
- 6 authorized for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2007 from the effective
- 7 date of this Act to implement a reduction of work-week hours for
- 8 employees within the Executive Branch departments and agencies
- 9 subject to the following conditions:
- 10 (a) Such reduction of hours shall not exceed five (5) hours
- 11 per week.
- 12 (b) Nothing herein shall be interpreted to allow a reduction
- in a classified employee's rate of compensation; however,
- weekly earnings shall decrease in direct correlation to a
- decrease in work-week hours.

- 1 (c) No full-time employee whose hours are reduced will lose
- any benefits the employee received prior to the implementation
- of the reduction of the work-week hours.
- 4 (d) The change shall not affect the employee's accrual of
- 5 years of service for the purposes of retirement.
- 6 (e) This section does not apply to uniformed public safety
- 7 personnel or to federally funded positions which Fifty Percent
- 8 (50%) or more of the salary is federally funded.
- 9 **Section 3. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or
- the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid,
- such invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of
- 12 this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or
- 13 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
