AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5, CHAPTER V OF PUBLIC LAW 28-150 RELATIVE TO REQUIRING A FISCAL RECOVERY PLAN FROM THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 5, Chapter V of Public Law 28-150 is hereby is amended
 to read:

"Section 5 (a). Revenue Tracking Report. The Director of the Bureau
of Budget and Management Research, in collaboration with the Director of
Revenue and Taxation and the Director of Administration shall determine, *no later than* thirty (30) days *after* the close of each month of Fiscal Year 2007, the
revenue tracking for the balance of the fiscal year, based upon the actual
collections of the preceding month and prepare a comparative statement of
the "actual" and "projected" revenues. Such information shall be compiled in

a Report, certified by each of the aforementioned Directors and submitted to 1 the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than thirty (30) days after the close 2 of each month of the fiscal year. 3 Section 5 (b). Fiscal Realignment Plan. Thirty (30) days after the close of each 4 guarter of the fiscal year, the Directors of the Department of Administration, 5 Revenue and Taxation, and the Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall 6 determine if actual revenues collected for the guarter are on track with the projected 7 revenues for the fiscal year. If projected Fiscal Year 2007 revenues, based on 8 collection experience, results in a three percent (3%) fluctuation in revenues as 9 adopted in Public Law 28-149, I Maga'låhen Guåhan shall submit to I Liheslatura a 10 Fiscal Realignment Plan which will address the revenue fluctuation. Such report 11 may include, but is not limited to, cost-containment measures to be implemented, 12 governmental reorganization plans and/or other actions to be initiated." If 13 necessary, to effectuate the provisions in this section, the Governor shall submit to I 14 Liheslatura proposed legislation, together with the Fiscal Realignment Plan 15 aimed at implementing the requirements of the Fiscal Realignment Plan. 16
