AN ACT TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS TO THE  
GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, THE GUAM  
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY, THE  
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES, AND THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY  
GENERAL, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** The Guam Legislature  
3 finds that the refinancing of the government of Guam General Obligation Bonds,  
4 1993 Series A will generate the sum of Nine Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight  
5 Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars (\$9,828,429) as a result of the debt  
6 service savings in Fiscal Year 2008 and further finds that there are additional  
7 funding requirements for the Guam Public School System, the Guam Memorial  
8 Hospital Authority, the Department of Public Health and Social Services and the  
9 Office of the Attorney General. Pursuant to these findings, the debt service  
10 savings are appropriated to these entities in Section 3 of this Act.

11 **Section 2. Amend Section 3(A) of Chapter I of Public Law 29-19 to**  
12 **read:**

13 **“A. GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS 1993 SERIES A**  
14 **(For education capital projects; Real Property Taxes pledged;**

1 due FY 2018 as final year; P.L. 22-19 and P.L. 22-24, net  
2 of UOG Bond Payment Obligation \$2,027,377) ~~\$10,591,974~~ \$763,545 1/

3 **1/ Territorial Education Facilities Fund”**

4 **Section 3. Appropriations.** Notwithstanding §22425(l) of Chapter 22 of  
5 Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the following subsections are appropriated  
6 from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund, as a result of the refinancing of the  
7 government of Guam General Obligation Bonds, 1993 Series A:

8 **a.** The sum of Four Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars  
9 **(\$4,150,000)** is appropriated from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the  
10 Guam Public School System for the implementation of the 3.5% salary adjustment  
11 approved by the Civil Service Commission for classroom teacher positions  
12 including librarians and counselors. Of the sum appropriated in this subsection,  
13 \$150,000 shall be used to fund the operations (including personnel) of the Office  
14 of the Adequate Education *Suruhanu* mandated by §1100, Chapter 11 of Title  
15 17GCA.

16 **b.** The sum of One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars **(\$1,100,000)**  
17 is appropriated from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the Guam  
18 Memorial Hospital Authority to supplement its operations.

19 **c.** The sum of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars **(\$900,000)** is  
20 appropriated from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the Medically  
21 Indigent Program Payment Revolving Fund (MIPPR) to supplement the funding  
22 for the Medically Indigent Program (MIP). The Department of Public Health and  
23 Social Services is authorized to use these funds for payment of prior years’ MIP  
24 obligations.

25 **d.** The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars **(\$500,000)** is  
26 appropriated from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the Office of the

1 Attorney General for the payment of the court settlement in the case of Haeuser vs.  
2 Law vs. CSC (SP0003-92/CIV94-00007).

3 e. The sum of Three Million One Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Four  
4 Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars (**\$3,178,429**) is appropriated from the Territorial  
5 Education Facilities Fund to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority to fund  
6 renovations, repairs and essential collateral equipment for the Hospital's  
7 Emergency Room.

8 f. The appropriations made in this section shall not be subject to the  
9 Governor's Transfer Authority as provided for in Public Law 29-19.

10 **Section 4. Technical Amendment.** Section 91 of Part II of Chapter VI  
11 of Public Law 29-19 is amended to read:

12 **“Section 91. Department of Public Health and Social Services.** Of the  
13 sum appropriated in Section 28 of ~~this Chapter~~ Part II of Chapter V of this Act  
14 to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund, Three Million One Hundred  
15 Three Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$3,103,460) *shall* be transferred  
16 to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for its operations for  
17 Fiscal Year 2008.”

18 **Section 5.** Section 1(c) and (d) of Part I of Chapter III of Public Law 29-  
19 19 are amended to read:

20 **“(c) Medically Indigent Program.** The sum of Fifteen Million Eight  
21 Hundred One Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-three Dollars (**\$15,801,433**) is  
22 appropriated from the General Fund to the Medically Indigent Program Payment  
23 Revolving Fund (MIPPR) for the Medically Indigent Program (MIP). The  
24 Department of Public Health and Social Services is authorized to use these  
25 funds for payment of prior years' MIP obligations.

1           **(d) Medicaid Program.** The sum of Twelve Million Nine Hundred  
2 Eleven Thousand Dollars (**\$12,911,000**) is appropriated from the General Fund to  
3 the Department of Public Health and Social Services for the local match  
4 requirement of the Medicaid Program. The Department of Public Health and  
5 Social Services is authorized to use these funds for payment of prior years'  
6 Medicaid obligations."
