## AN ACT TO ADD NEW §§ 25.50 & 25.55 TO CHAPTER 25, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE SOLICITATION OF CHILDREN OVER THE INTERNET OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS FOR IMMORAL PURPOSES.

## **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. A new Section 25.50 is hereby added to Chapter 25, Title 9,
Guam Code Annotated to read:

5 §25.50. Enticing child to enter vehicle, house, etc., for immoral 6 purposes. A person aged eighteen (18) years or older shall be guilty of a second 7 degree felony if he or she knowingly solicits, entices, allures, persuades or invites, 8 or attempts to solicit, entice, allure, persuade or invite, any child under sixteen 9 (16) years of age to enter any vehicle, room, house, office or other place for the 10 purpose of proposing to engage in any sexual act with or against the child where 11 such act is a violation of Chapter 25, 28 or 89 of 9GCA.

12 (2) Every person who is convicted of a violation of this section shall be
13 punished by incarceration for a period of not less than five (5) years and no more
14 than fifteen (15) years.

1 (3) It shall not constitute a defense against any charge or violation of this 2 section that a law enforcement officer, peace officer, or other person working at 3 the direction of law enforcement was involved in the detection or investigation of 4 a violation of this section.

6 Section 2. A new Section 25.55 is hereby added to Chapter 25, Title 9,

## 9 §25.55. Enticing Of Children Over The Internet -- Penalties

(1) A person aged eighteen (18) years or older shall be guilty of a second
degree felony if he or she knowingly uses the internet or other electronic means to
solicit, seduce, lure, persuade or entice by words or actions, or both, a minor child
under the age of sixteen (16) years or a person the defendant believes to be a
minor child under the age of sixteen (16) years to engage in any sexual act with or
against the child where such act is a violation of Chapter 25, 28 or 89 of 9GCA.

16 (2) Every person who is convicted of a violation of this section shall be 17 punished by incarceration for a period of not less than five (5) years and no more 18 than fifteen (15) years.

(3) It shall not constitute a defense against any charge or violation of this
section that a law enforcement officer, peace officer, or other person working at
the direction of law enforcement was involved in the detection or investigation of
a violation of this section.

(4) The offense is committed in Guam for purposes of determining
jurisdiction if the transmission that constitutes the offense either originates in or is
received in Guam.
