

In light of the withdrawal by the author of Bill No. 96 (LS) by written notice dated December 12, 2007, I am hereby introducing a bill that will carry over, and

address the issue contained in Bill No. 96 (LS). If you recall, I introduced Bill No. 144 (EC) and later withdrew it when it was later noted that Bill No. 144 (EC) was a duplicate of Bill No. 96 (LS). My withdrawal of Bill No. 144 (EC) was because of the existence and validity then, of Bill No. 96 (LS).

Accordingly, the new Bill that this office is filing today is consistent with the Legislative Standing Rule with respect to introduction and filing of bills.

TO: Sen. Frank T. Ishizaki Chairman, Committee on Calendar FROM: Sen. Judi Guthertz 142-SUBJECT: Request to withdraw Bill 96 (LS)

I respectfully request that my Bill 96 (LS), "An act to amend §1907(b) of Title 1, and §4102(a) of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Office of the Public Auditor," be withdrawn for the following reasons:

I introduced Bill 96 (LS) during the April Session at the request of the Public Auditor. This was well before questions regarding her hiring practices were brought to light by the Attorney General, and that specific issue is still in the courts. I believe it would be inappropriate for this bill to go forward.
