- **Section 2.** A new Paragraph "(n)" is *added* to 89.01 of Chapter 89 of 9 GCA to read:
- "(n) Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Tracking Device is a device that monitors the location of the person wearing the device by means of the Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) network. These devices could be active or passive. An active GPS Tracking Device transmits location data on a real-time current basis to a central monitoring station. A passive GPS Tracking Device collects location data for a specified period of time for upload at a later period of time to a centralized monitoring system."

Section 3. A new Section 89.12 is added to Chapter 89 of 9 GCA to read:

- §89.12. Electronic Monitoring of Sex Offenders. (a) Where a person convicted of a sexual conduct offense is sentenced to a period of probation, the sentencing judge may require as a condition of such probation, that the offender wear an electronic monitoring device, to include a Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Tracking Device for any or all of the duration of such probation. Additionally, the judge may require that offender bear the cost to purchase or lease the electronic monitoring device.
- (b) Where a person convicted of a sexual conduct offense is released on parole from incarceration, the *Territorial Parole Board may* require as a condition of such parole, that the offender wear an electronic monitoring device, to include a *Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) Tracking Device* for any or all of the duration of such parole. Additionally, the *Territorial Parole Board may* require that offender bear the cost to purchase or lease the electronic monitoring device.
