AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ANTONIO B. WON PAT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY, GUAM TO ISSUE DIFFERENTIAL PAY TO EMT-B CERTIFIED FIREFIGHTERS OF THE AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING UNIT

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1. Legislative Intent.** The present state of the law, in regards
- 3 to firefighters on Guam, only authorizes differential pay to be issued to
- 4 those firefighters who are employed by the Guam Fire Department. There
- 5 are firefighters of the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority's
- 6 Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting Unit who also have additional
- 7 certification, making them viable to perform extra, EMT services that are of
- 8 beneficial use to the protection of the airport, its stakeholders and its
- 9 customers visitors to and residents of our island. Many of these services
- are provided to island residents leaving on commercial flights for medical

- 1 purposes. These potentially life-saving skills are not being put to use by
- 2 the qualified firefighters because of the present state of the law. This act
- 3 authorizes issuance of differential pay to these firefighters for providing
- 4 these additional, and beneficial, services within certain specific conditions.
- 5 Section 2. A new Subsection (a) is added to §6223 of Title 4 Guam
- 6 Code Annotated, relative to Firefighters EMT Duty, to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam,
- 8 Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Unit EMT-B Differential Pay. A
- 9 Firefighter in the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport Authority,
- 10 Guam, Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Unit (ARFF) who is a certified
- 11 Emergency Medical Technician-Basic (EMT-B) and who actually performs
- as an EMT-B during a period when he or she is assigned as an EMT-B shall
- 13 be entitled to differential pay calculated at the rate of his or her regular
- wage plus fifteen percent (15%). The differential shall be applicable only
- during a time of actual performance. The employee shall be compensated
- a minimum of three (3) hours for any period of actual performance up to
- three (3) hours, and hourly for the actual time of performance over three (3)

- 1 hours. Nothing herein shall require any ARFF personnel to become EMT-B
- 2 certified. Such certification shall be strictly voluntary."
