AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION TO HIRE NEW PERSONNEL WITHIN VARIOUS DIVISIONS TO ENHANCE COLLECTION EFFORTS AND COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL LAWS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

I Liheslaturan Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. 2 that the Department of Revenue and Taxation is finds 3 underemployed with reference to personnel who are able to monitor and 4 collect the payment of taxes due the government. In times when revenue is 5 scarce, it is counterproductive to cut back on the resources given to the 6 Department of Revenue and Taxation, because that is the department of the 7 government where money is taken in. If the government is not vigilant in 8 9 collecting taxes due and owing to it, it will be difficult to fund services demanded by the public. 10

Based on prior analysis within the department, it has been shown that hiring revenue agents and revenue officers more than makes up for the cost of their salaries. For example, hiring six revenue agents will cost approximately Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), yet those six agents can bring in One Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,600,000) in revenue for the government. By the same token, hiring 10 revenue officers will cost the government approximately Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000), yet these same ten revenue officers can bring in over Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000) for the government. The results are obvious.

In addition to merely collecting taxes, more personnel are needed at the Department of Revenue and Taxation for the purpose of regulating compliance with the laws of Guam. For this reason, additional resources are to be given to the Department of Revenue and Taxation.

Section 2. Appropriations. (a) Tax enforcement.
