## AN ACT TO AMEND §20104 OF TITLE 11, GUAM CODE RECORDING ANNOTATED RELATIVE THE TAX ON SECURED TRANSACTIONS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 Section 1. §20104 of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, as amended by 4 Public Law 29-02, is *amended* to read:

5 "§20104. Security Transactions: Amount. On every mortgage or pledge of lands, estate, or property, real or personal, whatsoever, where the 6 7 same *shall* be made as security for the repayment of any definite and certain sum of money loaned at the time or previously due and owing, or forborne 8 to be paid, being payable; and on any conveyance of a land, estate, or 9 10 property whatsoever, to be sold or otherwise converted into money, which shall be and is intended only as security, either by express stipulation or 11 otherwise, *shall* be paid a tax of Five Dollars (\$5.00) Two Dollars and Fifty 12 Cents (\$2.50) on each One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or fractional part 13 14 thereof; provided, that upon each and every assignment or transfer of any mortgage, lease, or renewal or continuance of any agreement or contract by 15 altering or otherwise, a tax shall be collected and paid at the same rate as 16 that imposed on the original document." 17
