AN ACT TO AMEND §5123(a) OF CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5
OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING VEHICLES PURCHASED OR LEASED BY
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM BE THE MOST FUEL
EFFICIENT MODEL AVAILABLE THAT WILL FULLFILL
THE INTENDED GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. §5123(a) of Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is
hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) The General Services Agency shall purchase or lease all motor
vehicles required for all government agencies as a fleet at lease once
every three (3) years. Vehicles purchased or leased shall be the most fuel
efficient model available that will fulfill the intended governmental
function and a life cycle cost-benefit analysis of the motor vehicles
should include projected fuel costs. No government agency may
purchase a motor vehicle not a part of the fleet without the written
authorization of the Chief Procurement Officer. This Section shall not be

1 interpreted to permit the lease of non-standardize fleet vehicles. The
2 Chief Procurement Officer shall authorize non-fleet purchase or lease
3 only if:

4 (1) the type of vehicle is not required by other governmental
5 agencies, or

6 (2) the vehicle is a replacement of a fleet vehicle which is no
7 longer in service and the governmental agency cannot
8 function without a replacement until the next fleet purchase,
9 provided that the replacement vehicle meets the same
10 specifications as the fleet vehicle being replaced.

11 (3) the vehicle shall be the most fuel efficient model available that
12 will fulfill the intended governmental function and a life cycle
13 cost-benefit analysis of the motor vehicles should include
14 projected fuel costs.
