AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES, AND INSTRUMENTALITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM, TO PAY **PRIOR** YEARS' AND **CURRENT** YEAR **OBLIGATIONS OWED** TO THE **GUAM** MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FROM FISCAL YEAR OPERATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS, AND FROM CARRY-**OVER AND** CONTINUING **OPERATIONAL** APPROPRIATIONS AUTHORIZED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

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Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Mina' Bente NuebiNa 3 Liheslaturån Guåhan finds that many departments, agencies and instrumentalities 4 5 of the Government of Guam still owe the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) for prior years' and current year obligations totaling approximately 6 \$2.5M as reported in GMHA's Aged Trial Balance Summary for Government of 7

Guam Agencies dated February 27, 2008. It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to ensure 8

that these obligations to the hospital are paid. 9

Obligations owed to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the Government of Guam, with outstanding prior years' and current year obligations to the GMHA, *shall* remit payments to the GMHA to liquidate such obligations. In the event that full remittance of amounts outstanding cannot be made by the respective government entity, payments may be made in installments and shall be in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the entity's quarterly appropriation allotment received for operations, inclusive of allotments received from authorized carry-over and continuing *operational* appropriations. Payments *shall* be made no later than the last day of each quarter, beginning in the 3rd quarter of fiscal year 2008. In the event that the outstanding obligation is less than the ten percent mandated by this section, the department, agency or instrumentality shall remit to the GMHA the total amount outstanding.
