AN ACT TO ZONE THE PREVIOUSLY UNZONED LOT NUMBER 5327 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO TO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL ("M-1") ZONE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds

3 that Lot Number 5327, in the Municipality of Dededo, which belonged to the Estate of

Pablo Sanchez was deeded back to the family by the Guam Ancestral Lands

5 Commission, pursuant to Public Laws 22-145, 23-23, 23-141, 25-45, 25-178, 26-36

6 and 26-100 which requires that excess federal properties turned over to the

government of Guam then be transferred over to the estates of the original landowners

pursuant to Public Law 25-145.

This parcel is on the frontage of the north-east side of Rout 3 referred as Ukudu,

Dededo. The frontage area is comprised of Agricultural (A) and Light Industrial ("M-

11 1") zone. The property was purchased from the Estate of Pablo Sanchez and is now

owned by Valeo, Inc. and the owner is developing a business that requires an M1 zone

designation.

14 Without an existing zone designation, the Guam Land Use Commission is

unable to act on this matter. Authority to establish a comprehensive zoning plan for

Ancestral Lands Commission properties including those released by the Commission

- 1 to original landowners lies exclusively with the Provisional Commission for the
- 2 Zoning of Ancestral Lands. Said Commission has not been empanelled since the
- 3 enactment of Public Law 28-133, leaving the landowner with no recourse other than to
- 4 request I Liheslaturan Guåhan to establish an appropriate zone for Lot Number 5327
- 5 in the municipality of Dededo.
- 6 Section 2. Lot Zoning. Notwithstanding any provision of law, Lot
- Number 5327 in the Municipality of Dededo is hereby zoned Light Industrial
- 8 ("M-1") zone.
