1 AN ACT TO AMEND §§2109 AND 2110 OF
2 CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 4, AND TO AMEND §§6227
3 AND 6228 OF CHAPTER 6 OF TITLE 4, ALL OF
4 THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
5 PROHIBITING "LAME DUCK" INCUMBENTS
6 FROM HIRING NEW, UNCLASSIFIED
7 EMPLOYEES FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF AN
8 ELECTION AND TO PROHIBIT SALARY
9 INCREASES TO UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES
10 FOLLOWING THE LOSS OF AN ELECTION OR
11 THE DECISION NOT TO SEEK RE-ELECTION BY
12 AN INCUMBENT ELECTED OFFICIAL.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

15 Section 1. Section 2109 of Chapter 2, Title 4 GCA is amended to read:

16 "Section 2109. Prohibition Against Hiring New, Unclassified Employees
17 Following the Defeat of an Incumbent in an Election. No new unclassified
18 employees may be hired in the Executive Branch of government following the defeat
19 of a sitting *Maga'lalen Guåhan* in a primary election or general election until after
20 such date that such *Maga'lalen Guåhan* leaves office. No new, unclassified
21 employees may be hired in any Legislative Office of a sitting Senator following the
22 defeat of such Senator in a primary or general election. No new contract workers or
23 unclassified employees may be hired in the Office of the Attorney General following

1 the defeat of such Attorney General in a primary or general election. No new,
2 unclassified employees may be hired in the Office of the Public Auditor following the
3 defeat of such Public Auditor in a primary or general election.”

5 **Section 2.** Section 2110 of Chapter 2, Title 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

6 **“Section 2110. Prohibition Against Hiring Unclassified Employees**
7 **Employed by Incumbents *Not* Seeking Re-election.** No new unclassified employees
8 may be hired in the Executive Branch of government after October 1st of the last year
9 of office of a sitting *Maga’lahen Guãhan* who is *not* seeking re-election until after
10 such date that such *Maga’lahen Guãhan* leaves office. No new, unclassified
11 employees may be hired in any Legislative Office of a sitting Senator, opting *not* to
12 seek re-election, after October 1st of the last year in office of such Senator. No new
13 contract workers or unclassified employees may be hired in the office of a sitting
14 Attorney General, opting *not* to seek re-election, after October 1st of the last year in
15 office of such Attorney General. No new, unclassified employees may be hired in the
16 office of a sitting Public Auditor, opting *not* to seek re-election, after October 1st of
17 the last year in office of such Public Auditor.”

19 **Section 3.** Section 6227 of Chapter 6, Title 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

20 **"Section 6227. Prohibition Against Salary Increases for Unclassified**
21 **Employees Following the Defeat of an Incumbent in an Election.** No unclassified
22 employees employed in the Executive Branch of government may receive a pay
23 increase following the defeat of a sitting *Maga’lahen Guãhan* in a primary election or
24 general election until after such date that such *Maga’lahen Guãhan* leaves office. No
25 unclassified employees employed in any Legislative Office of a sitting Senator may
26 receive a pay increase following the defeat of such Senator in a primary or general

1 election. No unclassified employees employed in any Mayoral Office of a sitting
2 Mayor may receive a pay increase following the defeat of such Mayor in a primary or
3 general election. No contract workers or unclassified employees employed in the
4 Office of the Attorney General may receive a pay increase following the defeat of
5 such Attorney General in a primary or general election. No contract workers or
6 unclassified employees employed in the Office of the Public Auditor may receive a
7 pay increase following the defeat of such Public Auditor in a primary or general
8 election”

10 **Section 4.** Section 6228 of Chapter 6, Title 4 GCA is *amended* to read:

11 **“Section 6228. Prohibition Against Salary Increases for Unclassified**
12 **Employees Employed by Incumbents *Not* Seeking Re-election.** No unclassified
13 employees employed in the Executive Branch of government may receive a pay
14 increase after October 1st of the last year of office of a sitting *Maga’lahen Guåhan*
15 who is *not* seeking re-election until after such date that such *Maga’lahen Guåhan*
16 leaves office. No unclassified employees employed in any Legislative Office of a
17 sitting Senator, opting *not* to seek re-election, may receive a pay increase after
18 October 1st of the last year in office of such Senator. No unclassified employees
19 employed in any Mayoral Office of a sitting Mayor, opting *not* to seek re-election,
20 may receive a pay increase after October 1st of the last year in office of such Mayor.
21 No contract workers or unclassified employees employed in the Office of the Attorney
22 General opting *not* to seek re-election, may receive a pay increase after October 1st of
23 the last year in office of such Attorney General. No contract workers or unclassified
24 employees employed in the Office of the Public Auditor opting *not* to seek re-election,
25 may receive a pay increase after October 1st of the last year in office of such Public
26 Auditor ”
