AN ACT TO AMEND 4GCA §8127 (a) RELATIVE TO  
MEDICAL EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR  
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM DISABILITY  
RETIREMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. 4GCA §8127 (a) is hereby amended to read:

3 “§8127. Same: Resumption of Employment.

4 (a) At least once each year during the first five (5) years following the  
5 allowance of a disability annuity to any member, and at least once in every  
6 three (3) year period thereafter, the Board of Trustees shall require any  
7 disability annuitant to undergo a medical examination to be made by a place  
8 mutually agreed upon, by a physician or physicians engaged by the Board.

9 The medical examination shall not be required after the member reaches the  
10 age or where years of actual service years plus actual years on disability  
11 equals the amount of years that would qualify him to retire as a regular  
12 retiree, whichever is earlier. If any examination indicates that the annuitant is  
13 no longer physically or mentally incapacitated for service, or that he is  
14 engaged or is able to engage in a gainful occupation, payment of the disability  
15 annuity is reinstated to the payroll, but in no case shall payments be made for

1 more than sixty (60) days after physicians and a medical consultant engaged  
2 by the Board find the annuitant is no longer incapacitated for service.”

3 **Section 2. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the  
4 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
5 invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this Act which  
6 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
7 end the provisions of this Act are severable.
