AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 7, SECTION 7113 OF TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO LIMITATIONS ON CAPACITY LEVELS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Amendment to Chapter 7, Section 7113 of Title 17 GCA.
- 3 Chapter 7, Section 7113, of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 "§ 7113. Limitations on Capacity Levels for the Construction of New
- 6 Public Schools.

- All public schools built on Guam shall be designed and constructed for
- 8 student enrollment capacity limits as follows:
 - (a) Elementary Schools: five hundred fifty (550) students;
- (b) Middle Schools: seven hundred (700) students; and
- (c) High Schools: one thousand two hundred (1,200) students.

The school capacity limitations of this Section shall apply only to school projects initiated after September 30, 1997. The combined student enrollment in an existing school from any merger or consolidation of any existing schools at the time of such merger shall not exceed the capacity limits set herein. The GPSS may, subject to the approval of the Guam Education Policy Board, exceed the capacity limits for school mergers by not more than five percent (5%) set forth in this section provided that such merger adjustment would result in substantial cost savings and not endanger student and employee health and safety. These provisions shall not apply to school campuses that are temporarily used for double sessions.
