**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 63101 AND § 63133 TO CHAPTER 63 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; RELATIVE TO FISHING AND HUNTING LICENSE FEES FOR VETERANS.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** A new item (x) is hereby by added to § 63101 of Chapter 63 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

“(x) Eligible Veteran - is defined as any resident of Guam who has been honorably discharged or released under honorable circumstances from active service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States.”

**Section 2.** A new § 63133 is hereby added to Chapter 63 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

**“§ 63133. Veterans.**

Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, no fee, including application fees and issuance fees, may be charged of an applicant for a license, permit, stamp, tag, or certificate to hunt, fish, trap, or otherwise lawfully take fish, game, or any other wildlife in Guam who is an eligible veteran. To qualify for the waiver provided in this section, the eligible veteran shall present a copy of their DD-214 Form to the Director.”
