AN ACT TO CONSTRUCT A NEW JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL ON THE SITE OF THE EXISTING HIGH SCHOOL BY REQUIRING THE ISSUANCE OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE FINANCING, DESIGN, AND DEMOLITION OF THE EXISTING STRUCTURES AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW EDUCATIONAL FACILITY WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ENACTMENT OF THIS ACT INTO LAW BY ADDING A NEW TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED CHAPTER 58 § 58200.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan
- 3 finds that the students and staff of John F. Kennedy High School are
- 4 presently being forced to endure a double session at the George
- 5 Washington High School campus because of the delays that have already
- 6 occurred in the process of replacing the existing JFK campus.
- 7 I Liheslatura additionally finds that further delays in the process of
- 8 building a new campus for JFK students will only lengthen the double
- 9 sessions, perhaps for several more years. This is not in the best interests of
- the students of either high school, and is not in the best interests of the
- 11 people of Guam.

I Liheslatura therefore intends to move forward with the process of requiring the issuance of a request for proposals to build a new campus for the students of John F. Kennedy High School, to be located at the same site on which the current JFK stands. It is additionally the intent of I Liheslatura to fund the design, demolition, and construction of a new high school facility, including furniture, equipment and any necessary infrastructure upgrades, either through a Lease-Back process or through bond financing upon the maturation of the Limited Obligation (Section 30) Bonds Series A 2001 in Fiscal Year 2012.

## Section 2. A *new* Title 5 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 58 § 58200 is added to read:

"§ 58200. Request for Proposals for the construction of a new John F. Kennedy High School facility. Subject to the approval of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the government of Guam shall issue a Request for Proposals ("RFP") through the Department of Public Works, in compliance with the Guam Procurement Law and consistent with this §58200, for the financing, design, demolition of such portions of the existing John F. Kennedy High School as necessary, and construction of an Education Facility on the site of the existing John F. Kennedy High School. The new

Education Facility shall be known as the "John F. Kennedy High School." Such RFP shall contain the following:

- a. A requirement that the Contractor to be responsible for all costs, expenses and fees associated with the design, civil improvements, on-site and off-site infrastructure, construction, permits, and financing associated with the completion of the Education Facility, including the financing of furniture and equipment for the Education Facility. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the capital maintenance and upkeep of the Education Facility, excluding the furniture and equipment, throughout the term of the contractual agreement with the government of Guam.
- b. A requirement that each proposal submitted shall provide a minimum of three financing options, including a Lease or Lease-Back option pursuant to § 58104 of this Act, which shall not exceed 30 (thirty) years from the date of occupancy, as well as an option in which the government of Guam fully repays the Contractor for the Education Facility, including furniture and equipment, by Fiscal Year 2013.
- c. An option that allows the Contractor to assign, without need of consent, to any underwriter or other

appropriate party that has facilitated the issuance of the tax
exempt bonds or other financial vehicles necessary, to provide
the financing for the Education Facility.

d. A requirement that occupancy of the Education Facility take place no later than 9 (nine) months after execution of the Contract."

Section 3. Issuance of Request for Proposals. The Department of Public Works *shall* issue a Request for Proposals pursuant to the provisions of this Act *no later than* 30 days *after* the enactment of this Act into law.

**Section 4. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
