AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 22408 AND TO ADD SECTION 22408.1, BOTH OF CHAPTER 22 OF TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXTENDING CHARITABLE DONATIONS TO THE LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

## 1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Section 22408 of Chapter 22 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby
 *amended* to read as follows:

"§22408. Charitable Donations. The Governor, on behalf of the executive branch; the Speaker 4 of the Legislature, on behalf of the legislative branch; and the Chief Justice, on behalf of the judicial 5 branch are is authorized to accept monetary donations, as well as donated goods and services from 6 7 any individual or organization, which shall be deposited in a separate funds, respectively by the Treasurer of Guam. Such donations shall, upon authorization by the Governor, the Speaker or the 8 9 <u>Chief Justice, respectively</u>, be used and expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon which they were made. Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the Governor, the Speaker or 10 11 the Chief Justice, on behalf of their respective branches of the government of Guam from accepting 12 donations of property from any individual or organization."

Section 2. Section 22408.1 is hereby added to Chapter 22 of Title 5 of the Guam Code

1 Annotated to read as follows:

<u>"§22408.1. Reporting Guidelines.</u> In the event that donations are made pursuant to §22408 of
this Chapter, the Governor, on behalf of the executive branch; the Speaker, on behalf of the legislative
branch; and the Chief Justice, on behalf of the judicial branch, shall report any donations given to
their respective branches in their quarterly financial report. The report shall include the item(s),
service(s) and/or amount donated, the name of the individual or organization that has made such
donation, and the terms and conditions upon which they were made."
