AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION TO LICSENSE THE USE OF A 1.5 ACRE PORTION OF LOT NO. 86-R2, HAGÅTÑA, TO THE GOVGUAM ASSOCIATION OF RETIRED PERSONS INC., FOR A TERM OF 25 YEARS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A "MULIT-GENERATIONAL BUILDING."



## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the need for a multi-generational building is becoming more apparent as the number of Månamko' and the youth of the island continue to increase, yet the traditional connection and respect between the generations is being lost.

I Liheslatura finds that the Chamorro Land Trust Commission previously passed Resolution No. 2009-03, which endorsed the plans of the GovGuam Association of Retired Persons, Inc. (GGARP) to utilize a portion of Lot 86-R2, comprising an area of approximately 1.5 acres, Municipality of Hagåtña, subject to survey, for the proposed multi-generational facility.

I Liheslatura Guåhan takes due note of the fact that said parcel of land is located south of and adjacent to the present location (Lot-86-2) of the GovGuam

Association of Retired Persons, Inc. clubhouse in *Minondo, Hagåtña*, Municipality of *Hagåtña* is comprised of unutilized wetland.

I Liheslatura has been informed that the property is to be developed utilizing Block-Grant funds from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development. via the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. It has been determined in prior license agreements utilizing Chamorro Land Trust lands, that a period of twenty-one (21) years is insufficient for the term of the grant, and that a minimum term of twenty-five (25) years is necessary. Therefore, it is the intent of I Liheslatura to authorize the term of the license of twenty-five (25) years, notwithstanding the provision of Subsection (c) of §75107, Chapter 75, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, Which only provides for a term not to exceed twenty-one (21) years. 

Section 2. License of Property. Chamorro Land Trust Commission is hereby authorized to license a 1.5 acre portion of Lot No. 86-R2 (Map No. FY 88-249, Document No. 398140), municipality of *Hagåtña*, to the GovGuam Association of Retired Persons, Inc., for the development of a "multi-generational building."

Section 3. Term of License. Notwithstanding the provisions Subsection (c) of §75107, Chapter 75, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, the term of the license of the parcel of land authorized pursuant to this Act, *shall* be for a term of twenty-five (25) years. It is further, provided, that in the event the GovGuam Association of Retired Persons does not commence construction within five (5) years of the date of issuance of the license, the license shall then be deemed void, and the property shall revert to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission.

The license shall provide that the property shall not be sublet or transferred in any form to any other party or entity. Any attempt to dispose of the property for purposes not authorized pursuant to this Act shall be caused to revoke the license

- Section 4: Survey of Land. Any and all costs relative to apportioning of 1.5
- 5 acres of Lot No. 86-R2 (Map No. FY 88-249, Document No. 398140), to
- 6 GovGuam Association of Retired Persons, Inc., for the utilization of a Multi-
- 7 Generational Multi-purpose building, from the Government of Guam, shall be
- 8 borne by GovGuam Association of Retired Persons.
- 9 Section 5: Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon enactment.
- Section 6: Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to
  - any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
  - invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be
- given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the
- provisions of this Law are severable.
