AN ACT TO AMEND AND ADD §80128, TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, CHAPTER 80, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING TO THE GUAM PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM TO CONTRACT FOR LEASE OF A PORTION OF FRONTAGE PROPERTY AT THE NIEVES M. FLORES PUBLIC LIBRARY IN HAGATNA TO OPERATE A SMALL MOBILE FOOD ESTABLISHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan finds the need for the Guam Public Library System to be authorized, solicit and contract to lease of frontage property of the Nieves M. Flores Public Library (Hagatna Public Library) to a small mobile food establishment to provide drink and food services for library patrons and the general public.

I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan finds that many public libraries throughout the nation partner with "cafe" business establishments to improve services to library patrons. To better serve local library patrons, the Guam Public Library System seeks to contract with a "cafe" mobile food service business to be set-up at the outside premises of the Nieves M. Flores Public Library (Hagatna Public Library). Establishing an outside "cafe" like experience may also attract and increase more patrons and visitors to the establishment.

I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan finds that agencies may have enterprising opportunities that can fund operational needs. Allowing GPLS to lease a portion of frontage property at Nieves M. Flores Public Library to a business establishment will provide a new revenue generating source to support library infrastructure.

Section 2. A new Subsection §80128 added to Chapter 80, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read:

"§80128. Contract to lease of frontage property, in accordance with current procurement law, a food establishment to provide drink and food services for library patrons and the general public. This shall be limited to a small-size mobile food establishment, with services including, but are not limited to, the selling of coffee and other drinks or snacks, with a facility to consume them on the premises, or as deemed appropriate by the Library Board.

- (a) The solicitation and contracting for lease of frontage property to a food establishment may include, to the extent deemed practicable, appropriate and necessary, the use of the exterior frontage property of the Nieves M. Flores Memorial Library.
- (b) All funds received from the contract for lease of frontage property shall be maintained separate and apart from any other fund of the Government of Guam, and independent records, and an independent bank account shall be kept in connection with this fund. The revenue from the contract for lease of frontage property shall be used for facility maintenance or improvements. These funds will be used at the sole discretion of the Director of the Guam Public Library System.
- (c) Funds directed, as a result of revenue received from the contract for lease of frontage property, shall be subject to an annual audit by the Office of the Public Accountability."
 - Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon enactment.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which c can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
