AN ACT TO AMEND §3102.1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO FACILITATING THE PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING WAIVER OF DRIVER LICENSE FEES FOR VETERANS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan 1 finds that the current process for a Veteran to exercise the driver's license 2 fee waiver benefit authorized by P.L. 28-79 can be improved and made more 3 efficient. The current procedure requires the veteran to obtain from the 4 Government of Guam Office of Veterans Affairs (OVA) a verification of 5 eligibility by presenting a Department of Defense 214 Form (DD214) or 6 other documentation to verify eligibility for the waiver. This certification is 7 then taken to the License Division of the Department of Revenue and 8 9 Taxation (DRT) where the waiver is processed and the driver's license is

- issued. *I Liheslatura* intends to simplify the process to make obtaining the
- 2 waiver for driver's licenses less difficult for veterans by allowing them to
- 3 proceed directly to DRT to present the DD Form 214 or a DD Form 2
- 4 (Military Identification Card).

- Section 2. § 3102.1 of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- 7 § 3102.1. Waiver of Fees for Veterans.

The fee for an operator's or chauffeur's license is waived for veterans of the United States Armed Forces. Veterans include persons who served in the Guam Combat Patrol, the United States Navy Insular Forces, Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts, Philippines Scouts and the United States Armed Service.

Any person listed above and whose <u>character of military</u> service was honorable status can be as verified by the applicant's Report of Transfer or Discharge Department of Defense 214 Form (DD Form 214), or Department of Defense Form 2 (Military Identification Card), or other accepted forms used to verify membership in the organization listed and certified by the Government of Guam Office of Veterans

1	Affairs Office may apply to the License Division of the
2	Department of Revenue and Taxation for a Driver's License.
3	Certification by the OVA will be based only upon records they
4	have available. When requested by the OVA, the Department
5	of Revenue and Taxation shall provide a listing of Veterans
6	granted fee waivers.
7	Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon date of
