AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ITEM (I) TO §7118.1 OF CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE 22 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE DISCLOSURE OF AN **EMPLOYER'S** NAME, **ADDRESS TELEPHONE** AND NUMBER IN ADVERTISEMENTS OF JOB OPPORTUNITIES REQUIRED FOR CERTIFICATION OF TEMPORARY ALIEN LABOR

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1

- 2 **Section 1.** A new item (l) is hereby *added* to §7118.1 of Chapter 7 of Title 22 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows: 3
- "(1) All advertisements for job opportunities that are required by the 4 rules and regulations governing the certification of temporary alien 5 workers to Guam shall identify the employer's name, address and 6 telephone number." 7
- Section 2. Item (3) of §7104(a) of Chapter 7 of Title 17 of the Guam 8 Administrative Rules is hereby amended as follows: 9
 - "(3) Advertising Job Opportunities. The employer shall advertise a Job Opportunity for an Employment Position in a publication of general circulation in Guam, such advertisement including all terms and conditions of employment as may be offered for the Job Opportunity and Employment Position, for a period of three consecutive working days, and in such other media and for such

period as may be required by the United States government, after submitting an Application for Certification. Such advertising shall direct applicants to the Guam Employment Service of the Department of Labor, and shall not identify the employer's name, address or telephone number."
