AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS WITH THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO A LEASE OF ITS TALOFOFO PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF UTILIZING THE LEASEHOLD PAYMENTS AS A SOURCE FOR THE REPAYMENT OF FUNDS BORROWED TO DESIGN, CONSTRUCT, AND EQUIP ITS NEW FACILITY; AND, TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE 3 TO CHAPTER 20, TITLE 19, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE "DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS FACILITY FUND".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Intent. The Department of Youth Affairs (DYA) is in dire need of a new facility to accommodate the clients it currently houses, as well as to provide a safe and 3 rehabilitative environment for both status and non-status offenders. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan 4 5 Guåhan to provide the Department with the authority to seek out potential individuals or companies that would be interested in leasing their property in Talofofo. The leasehold payments would then be 6 a source of payment for the financing the design and construction of a new facility on its Mangilao 7 footprint. It is also the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan that DYA makes every effort to seek 8 9 financing from appropriate sources, such as the U.S Department of Agriculture, or other financing source, with lower cost of funds, for the amount deemed necessary. 10

Section 2. Authorization to lease property. The Department of Youth Affairs is authorized to enter into a long term lease of its Talofofo property, described as Lot No. 405, Talofofo, Guam, Estate No. 24059, Suburban, containing an area of 88,027 square meters, as shown on LM drawing No. E4-71T682. The proceeds from the lease *shall* be used to repay funds borrowed

- for the design, construction and equipping of a new facility on its Mangilao footprint, and for other
- allowed uses as contained in Section 3 of this Act. The lease *shall* be subject to legislative approval.
- 3 Section 3. A new Article 3 is added to Chapter 20, Title 19, Guam Code Annotated,
- 4 to read:

- 6 DYA FACILITY FUND
- 7 § 20300. Creation.
- 8 § 20301. Separate Fund and Bank Account.
- 9 § 20302. Purpose and Expenditures.
- 10 § 20303. Deposits.
- 11 § 20304. Administration.
- 12 § 20305. Investment.
- 13 § 20306. New DYA Facility Construction.
- 14 § 20307. Severability.
- 15 § 20300. Creation. There is hereby created, separate and apart from other funds of the
- government of Guam, a reserve fund known as the "DYA Facility Construction Fund".
- 17 § 20301. Separate Fund and Bank Account. The DYA Facility Construction Fund
- shall not be commingled with the General Fund or any other fund of the government of Guam. The
- 19 DYA Facility Construction Fund *shall* be maintained in a separate bank account.
- 20 § 20302. Purpose and Expenditures. The DYA Facility Construction Fund shall be
- 21 expended for the construction of the new Department of Youth Affairs Facility, including, but not
- 22 limited to, the following: A/E for the proposed building facility; environmental concerns;
- archeological and historic site survey and/or assessment of the project site; site preparation and civil
- 24 work for the building foundation; construction cost for the structure of the proposed building facility
- to be built on DYA's current Mangilao footprint.
- 26 § 20303. Deposits. All monies received from approved source(s) of funding for the
- 27 design, construction and equipping of the Department of Youth Affairs Facility shall be deposited
- 28 into the DYA Facility Construction Fund.
- 29 § 20304. Administration. The Director of Youth Affairs shall account for and
- 30 administer the DYA Facility Construction Fund. The Director shall keep all books, records, files and

- accounts of the DYA Facility Construction Fund. The Director shall prepare monthly reports relative
- 2 to the DYA Facility Construction Fund reflecting the transactions and the financial condition of the
- 3 DYA Facility Construction Fund, which monthly reports shall be transmitted to I Liheslatura and I
- 4 Maga'lahi.
- 5 § 20305. Investment. The Director of Youth Affairs, together with the Director of
- 6 Administration, shall invest money held in the DYA Facility Construction Fund in any type of
- 7 investment approved for the Retirement Fund. All proceeds and income from investments of the
- 8 DYA Facility Construction Fund *shall* be deposited in the DYA Facility Construction Fund.
- 9 § 20306. New DYA Facility Construction. (a) The Department of Youth Affairs is
- 10 hereby authorized to provide for the design, construction and collateral equipment of a new public
- facility by entering into a financing arrangement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, or other
- financing source, with lower cost of funds, not to exceed Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00), for
- a term *not to exceed* forty (40) years.
- 14 (b) Any financial arrangement to provide for the design, construction and collateral
- equipment of the DYA Facility shall be subject to the approval of the secured creditor of the
- 16 Department of Youth Affairs. The Director of Youth Affairs, without jeopardizing existing
- obligations, is authorized to use a portion of its Talofofo Leasehold, which shall be deposited into
- the DYA Facility Construction Fund to make repayment and assure that its loan installments are paid
- on time; for emergency maintenance; for extensions to facilities; and for replacement of short-lived
- assets with a useful life significantly *less than* the repayment period of any loan or the term, or any
- 21 other financial arrangement.
 - (c) Any monies reimbursed for expenses incurred on the design and construction of the DYA
- Facility shall revert to the DYA Facility Construction Fund.
- 24 (d) I Liheslaturan Guåhan encourages the Department of Youth Affairs to explore and
- 25 identify any and all potential financing sources or grants, including, but not limited to, any Federal
- 26 government instrumentalities or private financial lending sources for construction of the DYA
- 27 Facility.

- 28 (e) Interest derived from the financial agreement shall be exempt from taxation by the
- 29 Government.

(f) Notwithstanding any substantive *or* procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the government of Guam hereby waives immunity from any suit *or* action in contract on the loan, but does *not* waive sovereign immunity as to personal liability of elected *or* appointed officials and employees of the government of Guam.

§ 20307. Severability. If any provision of this Act, or its application to any person or circumstance, is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable."
