**AN ACT ADD A NEW § 3410 TO CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 16 OF
THE GUAM CODE; RELATIVE TO CURBSTONING.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:p**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 3410 is hereby *added* to Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam
3 Code Annotated to read:

4 **“§ 3410. Curbstoning; permit required.**

5 (a) It *shall* be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle on
6 public or private property having displayed thereon any writing indicating
7 that such vehicle is for sale without having a permit from the Guam Police
8 Department authorizing the sale of vehicles at that location.

9 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any one of the
10 following:

11 (1) A vehicle parked on private property having a permit from
12 the Guam Police Department authorizing the sale of vehicles at that
13 location;

14 (2) A single vehicle legally parked on the premises of, or in the
15 right-of-way immediately adjacent to a residence provided the vehicle
16 is owned by or registered to the occupant of the residence;

17 (3) A vehicle that is parked on either public or private property
18 adjacent to a building or location to which the vehicle owner has

1 traveled to perform his normal course of business or employment or
2 on a personal errand; *or*

3 (4) A vehicle that is parked on the premises of a bonafide auto
4 dealer.

5 (c) The Chief of Police in consultation with the Director of Revenue
6 and Taxation, the Director of the Department of Public Works, and the
7 Director of the Department of Land Management, *shall* promulgate rules and
8 regulations which shall include but not be limited to reasonable fines and
9 fees to enforce this Section. Such rules shall be subject to the Administrative
10 Adjudication Law.

11 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions of § 9502 of Chapter 9.5 of Title 7
12 Guam Code Annotated, all fees and fines collected under this Section shall
13 be deposited into the Police Services Fund and made available by
14 appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

15 (e) This Section shall take effect upon the promulgation rules of
16 regulations enforcing this Section.”
