2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: Section 1. §3105 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby
3	amended as follows:
4	"§ 3105. Guam Fire Department. There is within the Executive
5	Branch of the government of Guam a Guam Fire Department. The
6	Fire Chief is the head of the Department. The Fire Chief is
7	appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
8	Legislature. The Fire Chief shall meet the following qualifications:
9	(a)(1) Must have a bachelor's degree in Fire Science or
10	Public Administration or closely related field or discipline at
11	an accredited institution; and
12	(2) Have at least ten years of experience in fire control
13	including control and extinguishment of fires and fire
14	prevention, of which two years must be served in a position
15	equivalent to Battalion Chief or higher; or
16	(b)(1) Must have an associate's degree in Fire Science or
17	closely related field or discipline at an accredited

(2) Have at least 15 years experience in fire control, 1 including control and extinguishment of fires and fire 2 prevention, of which four years must be served in a position 3 equivalent to Battalion Chief or higher: or 4 (c)(1) Must have a Master's Degree in Fire Science or Public 5 Administration or closely related field or discipline at an 6 accredited institution; and 7 (2) Have at least five years of experience in fire control 8
