

AN ACT ADD A NEW §5220 TO CHAPTER 5 OF 5GCA RELATIVE TO POSTING IFBs AND RFPs ONLINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1

2 **Section 1.** A new Section 5220 is *added* to Chapter 5 of 5GCA to read:

- §5220. Publication of IFB and RFP documents on the Agency's Website. 4
- Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, Invitations for Bid (IFBs) and 5
- Requests for Proposals (RFPs) shall be posted on the procuring agency's website. 6
- IFBs and RFPs procured through the General Services Agency (GSA) or the 7
- 8 Department of Public Works (DPW) shall be posted, on the date of the IFB/RFP
- announcement, simultaneously on the procuring agency's website and the websites of 9
- 10 GSA and DPW respectively. No fees shall be assessed to prospective bidders or
- other parties for accessing/downloading procurement documents from an agency's 11
- website. Such documents shall remain on the respective agencies' websites for a 12
- period of not less than one hundred eighty (180) days following the award of the Bid 13
- or Proposal. 14
- (b) The GSA/DPW shall provide notice in each IFB/RFP announcement that 15
- recommends that prospective bidders/respondents register contact information with 16
- the agency to ensure that they receive any notices regarding any changes or updates 17
- to the IFB/RFP. The GSA/DPW shall not be liable for failure to provide notice to 18
- 19 any party who did not register contact information.

- 1 (c) Nothing herein is intended to prevent the procuring agency, GSA, or DPW from
- 2 making physical or digital media copies of procurement documents and assessing
- 3 reasonable fees for such documents in manner consistent with Public Law,
- 4 Administrative Rules and Regulations, and departmental policy that existed prior to
- 5 the enactment of this section.
