8	(a) It shall be unlawful for any employer to ask any employee to provide any	
9	username, password, or other related account information in order to gain access to a	
10	social networking website where that employee maintains an account or profile.

12	(b) It shall be unlawful for any employer to ask any prospective employee to provide	
13	any username, password, or other related account information in order to gain access to	
14	a social networking website where that prospective employee maintains an account or	
15	profile.

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(d) It shall be unlawful for any employer to ask any prospective employee to provide
any username, password, or other related account information in order to gain access to
a non-employer provided email account.

10 pursuant a valid court order or are required by federal law for purposes of national or

(f) Violations of paragraphs (a), (b), (c) or (d) of this section are "violations"
punishable by a fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for the first offense and
Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for subsequent offenses.

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
