### AN ACT TO AMEND §§ 3114 OF 16GCA, 57103 OF 10GCA, 4121 OF 4GCA AND 1107 OF 17GCA RELATIVE TO GOVERNMENT OF GUAM ID CARDS ISSUED TO PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE.

#### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:** 1

2 Section 1. Section 3114 of Article 1, Chapter 3 of 16GCA is *amended* to read as follows: 3

#### §3114. Licenses Issued to Minors Persons Under 21 Years of Age. 5

All licenses issued to persons under the age of eighteen (18) twenty-one (21) years of 6 age shall prominently display the month and year in which such person will turn 7 eighteen (18) twenty-one (21) years of age or the general appearance of the licenses 8 issued persons under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be substantially different from 9 those licenses issued to persons twenty-one years of age or older. 10 11

§57103. Certificates of Identification Issued to Minors Persons Under 21 Years of 16 17 Age.

All certificates of identification issued to persons under the age of eighteen (18)
 <u>twenty-one (21)</u> years of age shall prominently display the month and year in which

## 9 §4121. Employment Identification Cards Issued to Minors Persons Under 21 10 Years of Age.

All employment identification cards issued to persons under the age of eighteen (18) <u>twenty-one (21)</u> years of age, who are employed in any branch of the government of Guam, including the Guam Legislature, Judiciary and Executive Branch, including all public corporations, autonomous agencies, the University of Guam and the Guam Community College shall prominently display the month and year in which such person will turn eighteen (18) twenty-one (21) years of age.

19 Section 4. Section 1107 of Chapter 1, Division 1 of 17GCA is *amended* to read as20 follows:

## §1107. Student Identification Cards Issued to Minors Persons Under 21 Years of Age.

All student identification cards issued to persons under the age of eighteen (18) <u>twenty-one (21)</u> years of age, who are enrolled in any public education institution of the government of Guam, including the Department of Education, the University of Guam and the Guam Community College shall prominently display the month and year in which such person will turn eighteen (18) twenty-one (21) years of age.
