AN ACT TO REPROGRAM THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$375,000.00) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PAVING OF VILLAGE STREETS AND THE REPAIR OF DAMAGES TO VILLAGE STREETS AS A RESULT OF TRAFFIC DIVERSION RELATED TO ONGOING ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation to the Department of Public Works for Various**
3 **Road Repairs.** The sum of Three Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars
4 **(\$375,000.00)** is hereby appropriated from the balance of the appropriations contained
5 §1513 of Article 5, Chapter 1 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to the Department of
6 Public Works for said purposes.

7 **Section 2. Additional Authorizations.** Of the amounts appropriated in
8 Section 1 of this Act, *not less than:*

9 (a) Three Hundred Forty Five Thousand Dollars **(\$345,000.00)** is
10 reserved for Roy T. Damian Street, aka Route 33
11 Mongmong/Toto/Maite, for spot repair of street damage caused by

1 heavy travelers' use to bypass the major construction work in
2 Hagatna.

3 (b) Thirty Thousand Dollars (**\$30,000.00**) is reserved for Mamis
4 Street, Mangilao for the paving of a portion of a second lane to be
5 installed.

6 (c) The funds identified herein *shall* be applied *solely* for the purposes
7 set forth.
