

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §12803(a) OF CHAPTER 12, OF  
TITLE 10 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO AMENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE  
AND TO PROVIDE FOR STAGGERED TERMS FOR  
THE MEMBERS OF THE GUAM BOARD OF ALLIED  
HEALTH EXAMINERS.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** §12803(a) of Chapter 12, Title 10, of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

“(a) Creation. There is established, in and for the government of Guam, a Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, composed of a representative from each of the profession being examined for licensure of which currently there are

1 nine (9) members appointed by *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*. *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*  
2 *shall* appoint two (2) additional members, one (1) member for the Respiratory  
3 Therapist and one (1) member for the Nutritionist/Clinical Dietician, and *shall*  
4 appoint additional members for other allied health profession being examined  
5 for licensure that the Board includes in its licensing procedure and specifically  
6 recommend to *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* to appoint a board member representative.  
7 There *shall* be *no* Board member appointment with *less than* ten (10) allied  
8 health professionals qualified applicants for licensure within that allied health  
9 profession of the applicants. The appointment of all current members of the  
10 Board *shall* terminate sixty (60) days after the enactment of this Act. All  
11 appointments made to the Board *shall* be subject to the advice and consent of *I*  
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Appointments *shall* be made so that four (4) members  
13 *shall* serve for a term of three (3) years and the remaining members *shall* serve  
14 for a period of five (5) years. *No* Board member *shall* serve *more than* two (2)  
15 consecutive terms. The Board *shall* examine applicants for licensure within the  
16 allied health professions *not* having separate Board of Examiners enacted by *I*  
17 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*.”

18 **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application  
19 to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall *not* affect  
20 other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without  
21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act  
22 are severable.
