



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEASE OF LOT NO. 2065, ANIGUA, TO THE CHAMORU CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION; TO ADD A NEW §849.2 TO ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 1 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED; AND TO CITE THE ACT AS THE "Plazan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao Act of 2008".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUÂHAN:

3	Section 1. Title. This Act may be cited or referred to as the "Plazan
4	Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao Act of 2008''.
5	Section 2. Legislative Findings. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the
6	government of Guam over the years has experienced difficulty in the general
7	maintenance and upkeep of its public parks located around the island due to
8	financial challenges that have directly affected the ability of certain government
9	agencies from maintaining public parks and facilities. As a result of this situation,
10	businesses and non-profit organizations have become active in supporting the
11	island's community through assisting directly in the maintenance and upkeep of
12	several public parks and facilities. Such an organization is the <i>Chamoru Cultural</i>
13	Development and Research Institute.
14	The Chamoru Cultural Development and Research Institute has volunteered
15	to maintain the area and to insure the park's accessibility to the people of Guam.
16	More importantly, <i>I Liheslaturan Guåhan</i> finds that there is a need to insure that
17	this park is maintained regularly and made accessible to the people of Guam. The
18	Chamoru Cultural Development and Research Institute has expressed an interest in
19	the possible lease of the area in an effort to increase its beauty and use by the
20	public.
21	It is, therefore, the intent of <i>I Liheslaturan Guåhan</i> to authorize the lease of
22	this property to a non-profit organization to insure sufficient maintenance,
23	administration and use of the public park facility by members of the organization
2 <i>3</i> 24	and most importantly, the people of Guam.
2 4 25	Section 3. Authorization to Lease. I Maga'lahen Guåhan is hereby
25 26	authorized to lease Lot No. 2065. Anigua, containing an area of 2.137.11 + square

meters, as shown on the map recorded in the Department of Land Management

1 under Instrument Number 89939, to the Chamoru Cultural Development and

2 Research Institute, a non-profit organization, at the rate of \$1.00 per year for a

3 term of fifty (50) years, renewable for another fifty (50) years, to construct

- 4 recreational facilities, which facilities and park shall be open to the general public.
- 5 Such lease *shall not* be assigned *or* the property subleased without the approval of
- 6 I Liheslaturan Guåhan. A change in the non-profit status or the purpose of the
- 7 organization named here shall constitute termination of the lease unless approved
- 8 anew by I Liheslaturan Guåhan.

- **Section 4. Renaming.** A new §849.2 is hereby *added* to Article 1 of 10 Chapter 8 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
 - "§849.2. (a) Name Designation. "Plazan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao" or "Chief Hurao Memorial Park". That area known as Lot No. 2065, Anigua, containing an area of 2,137.11 ± square meters, as shown on the map recorded in the Department of Land Management under Instrument Number 89939, and surrounding government properties, shall hereafter be known as the "Plazan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao" or "Chief Hurao Memorial Park". Any provisions of law referring to the former site of the Department of Land Management are hereby deemed to read: "Plazan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao" or "Chief Hurao Memorial Park".
 - (b) Appropriate nameplates or signs. The Chamoru Cultural Development and Research Institute, together with I Maga'lahen Guåhan, the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Director of the Department of Public Works and the Mayor of Hagåtña, shall cause to be erected appropriate nameplates or signs designating the site as the "Plazan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao" or "Chief Hurao Memorial Park". Further, at such ceremony as the Chamoru Cultural Development and Research Institute, I Maga'lahen Guåhan, the Director of Public Works, the Director

of the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Mayor of *Hagåtña* deem appropriate, "*Plasan Memoriat Maga'lahi Hurao*" or "*Chief Hurao Memorial Park*" shall be officially named and a statue and a plaque bearing the name, picture, and a brief history of the contributions of *Chief Hurao* to the people of Guam shall be affixed within a suitable spot in and around the park area."

Section 5. Severability. *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity *shall* not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
