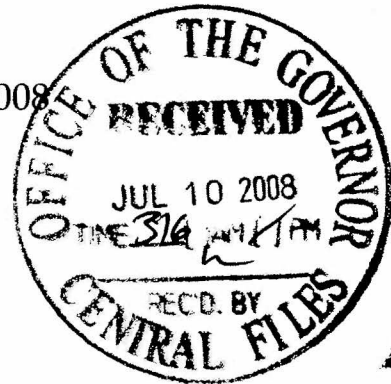




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SUBSECTION (b) OF §19.30 OF
CHAPTER 19 OF TITLE 9 OF THE GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AGAINST A PEACE
OFFICER.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of §19.30 of Chapter 19 of Title 9 of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

"(b) An assault against a peace officer who is performing his official duties as a peace officer is a felony of the third degree if the perpetrator knew *or* should have known that the victim was a peace officer. In any assault against a peace officer, the jury *shall*, with any finding of guilty, also

1 return a finding as to whether the perpetrator had actual knowledge that the
2 victim was a peace officer. *If* the jury finds that the perpetrator had actual
3 knowledge that the victim was a peace officer, the court *shall* impose a
4 minimum sentence of one (1) year in prison without suspension, probation,
5 parole, *or* work release. For purposes of this §19.30, *peace officer* means
6 one so defined in §5.55, Title 8, Guam Code Annotated, and to also include
7 those individuals serving in a volunteer law enforcement capacity within any
8 government of Guam law enforcement entity."
