AN ACT TO CONDITIONALLY APPROVE THE JOSE D. LEON GUERRERO COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM MASTER PLAN UPDATE 2007 REPORT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam's Master Plan was last updated and approved in 1999. Though the Master Plan has provided the Port with the guidance on the development of its properties, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Master Plan should be updated to meet the growth of our economy and the

impact of the proposed relocation of the U. S. Marine Corps troops from Okinawa 1 2 to Guam.

3 After conducting two (2) public hearings on the update of the Master Plan, 4 the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Board of Directors approved the Master Plan Update 2007 Report on May 8, 2008. In accordance with Title 5, 5 6 Guam Code Annotated, Article 2, §1205, a public hearing was held on September 7 4, 2008 by the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, whereby the public was given the 8 opportunity to submit written and oral testimonies on the Master Plan Update 2007 Report. On September 18, 2008, the Bureau of Statistics and Plans recommended 9 10 to I Maga'lahen Guåhan to transmit the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update 2007 Report to I Mina' Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan for the final approval and adoption as an official element in Guam's 12 13 Comprehensive Development Plan.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that insufficient funds currently exist to implement the Port's Master Plan. The Port has stated it will pursue the financing required to implement this Plan, and will submit a revised Economic Impact Study, a revised Financial Feasibility Study, and an Implementation Plan before any commitment is made by the Port to bind it or the government of Guam to the improvement outlined. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that investment by the private sector is a necessary component to the improvement and development of the facilities at the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam and that such investment is facilitated by leases or other land use arrangements for periods beyond five (5) years.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan, therefore, intends to conditionally approve the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Master Plan Update 2007 Report subject to submission and approval of additional information required to be part of a comprehensive Master Plan.

Section 2. Master Plan Conditionally Approved. The Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Master Plan Update 2007 Report is hereby conditionally approved by I Liheslaturan Guåhan, subject to I Liheslatura's subsequent approval of the Financial Feasibility Plan and Economic Impact Assessment to be submitted by the Board of Directors of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam, and further subject to the submission by the Board, and approval by I Liheslatura, of an Implementation Plan that establishes the priorities, identifies viable funding sources and classifies projects according to whether it is for the Port's organic growth or for the military build up.

Section 3. Notwithstanding any provision of the Plan itself, *neither* the passage of this Act *nor* the conditional approval of the Master Plan *shall* be construed to *amend* §10105(i) of Chapter 10, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of the Plan, *neither* the passage of this Act *nor* the conditional approval of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update 2007 Report *shall* be construed to repeal *or* amend any existing law, statute, rule *or* regulation without subsequent and express repeal *or* amendment by *I Liheslatura*.

Section 5. Severability. *If* any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable.
