

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §5123(a) OF CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5 OF
THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING VEHICLES PURCHASED *OR* LEASED BY THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM BE THE MOST FUEL EFFICIENT
MODEL AVAILABLE THAT WILL FULLFILL THE
INTENDED GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §5123(a) of Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, is
3 hereby *amended* to read as follows:

1 “(a) The General Services Agency *shall* purchase or lease all motor
2 vehicles required for all government agencies as a fleet at least once every
3 three (3) years. The Chief Procurement Officer *shall* maintain a vehicle
4 purchase policy that considers the *total cost of ownership* that includes, but
5 is *not* limited to, (1) the intended purpose for which the vehicle is purchased
6 (2) the purchase price of the vehicle; (3) the United States EPA estimated
7 mileage ratings in terms of Miles Per Gallon (MPG) for the vehicle; (4) the
8 expected useful life of the vehicle; (5) the cost of maintenance and
9 warranties over the expected useful life of the vehicle; and (6) any ratings *or*
10 reviews from consumer rating companies on the performance, mileage and
11 reliability of the vehicle. This Section *shall not* be interpreted to permit the
12 lease of non-standardized fleet vehicles. The Chief Procurement Officer
13 *shall* authorize non-fleet purchase *or* lease only *if*:

14 (1) the type of vehicle is *not* required by other governmental
15 agencies; *or*

16 (2) the vehicle is a replacement of a fleet vehicle which is no
17 longer in service and the governmental agency cannot function
18 without a replacement until the next fleet purchase, provided, that the
19 replacement vehicle meets the same specifications as the fleet vehicle
20 being replaced.”
