AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §14241 TO ARTICLE 2 OF **CHAPTER** 14. TITLE 12 **OF** THE **GUAM** ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY FINANCING OPTIONS FOR THE GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR EFFICIENT **ORDERLY OPERATIONS** AND AND TO **PROMOTE** GROWTH ON GUAM FOR THE BETTERMENT OF ALL ITS RESIDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the Guam

Waterworks Authority recently imposed a temporary moratorium on sewer connections in Central Guam in order to prevent sewage overflows that pose a threat to human health, and to ensure compliance with the Clean Water Act. However, that moratorium has had an understandable, albeit adverse impact on the course of economic development on Guam by either delaying *or* scrapping construction projects which has in turn caused either a temporary *or* permanent loss of revenue for the government of Guam through increased taxes on those

8 activities and the resultant economic use and the loss of income from those seeking

to develop their properties.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that given the Guam Waterworks Authority has neither the time nor the luxury of procuring construction or financing a fix to the moratorium in the traditional methods provided for under Guam law, in light of the problems in the world credit markets and since the Guam Economic Development Authority has recently learned from GWA's bond underwriters that it would be unlikely to issue bonds in the near future thereby making the declaration of an emergency inevitable in order to not impede economic growth which is so important to the long-term well being of Guam's citizens.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further declares that the aforementioned moratorium and similar capacity-related problems, which may arise from time-to-time, are an emergency and as such, does hereby authorize the Guam Waterworks Authority to enter into financing and construction contracts, subject to regulatory oversight from the Guam Economic Development Authority and the Guam Public Utilities Commission.

Section 2. A new §14241 is hereby *added* to Chapter 14, Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

"§14241. Approval of Financing and Construction Options to

2	Water and Wastewater System. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision
3	of law, in order to eliminate the emergency that currently exists relative to
4	the current Guam Waterworks Authority's moratorium on sewer connections
5	in Central Guam, the Guam Waterworks Authority is hereby authorized to
6	enter into long-term and short-term financing agreements, credit facilities
7	and other construction and procurement models which are necessary to
8	rapidly alleviate the moratorium in order to promote economic growth on
9	Guam for the betterment of all, provided, however, that said financing shall
.0	be issued subject to the terms and conditions of GWA's 2005 Series Bond
1	Indenture and any other supplemental indenture issued by the Authority
2	under Public Law 28-71.
13	(b) Financing agreements, credit facilities and procurement
4	methods can include, but are not limited to, the following:
5	(1) qualified public activity bonds;
6	(2) certificates of participation;
7	(3) design-build-finance agreements;
18	(4) build-operate-transfer agreements;
19	(5) build-lease agreements;
20	(6) lease-to-own agreements; and
21	(7) any other credit facility or financing agreement approved
22	by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities.
23	(c) All contracts for financing and construction entered into under
24	this Section shall be subject to the approval of the Guam Public Utilities
25	Commission under the Contract Review Protocol.

(d)

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All financing entered into under this Section shall be subject to

the approval of the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) and

all fees due to GEDA under existing statutes to GEDA *shall* apply. However, all other provisions of §50103(k) of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, *shall not* apply.

- (e) Prior to issuing any financing under this provision, the Guam Waterworks Authority *shall* obtain a legal opinion from a licensed Bond Counsel designated by the Authority who possesses a national reputation for expertise in matters relating to governmental obligations, the interest on which is excluded from gross income for federal income tax purposes under Section 103 of the United States' Internal Revenue Code.
- (f) In view of the urgency for the procurement in order to lift the moratorium in Central Guam and only for the project as defined herein, the requirements of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, are hereby waived and the Guam Waterworks Authority is hereby authorized to utilize such method of source selection as it deems necessary, subject to the approval of the Guam Public Utilities Commission under the Contract Review Protocol and with all financing to be approved by the Guam Economic Development Authority. However, the following minimum limitations apply to the procurement for this project:
 - (1) A competitive selection request *shall* be published in a newspaper published on Guam for on at least two (2) occasions at least thirty (30) days prior to the date set to select the best bid/proposal to GWA based on the lowest overall life cycle costs and financing; and
 - (2) GWA *shall not* use *sole* source as a method of selecting the successful bidder/proposer.
 - (g) The moratorium project is defined to mean:

(1) Upgrades to the *Mamajanao* Sewage Pump Station (SPS): This will include an extension of the force main down the hill to a new terminating manhole and will control the flows from the pumping station.

- (2) Route 16 Pump Station Operational Measures: Increase risk management measures at the Route 16 sewage pump station and eliminate the flow split to the south.
- (3) Route 4 Wastewater Piping: Pipe the flow from the New *Chaot* SPS directly to the Agana WWTP.
- (4) Tamuning Pump Station: Build a new sewage pump station in Tamuning that will collect all of the flow from Marine Corps Drive and pump it directly to the Agana WWTP.
- (5) Agana Main Pump Station: Upgrade the Agana Main SPS and provide a fat, oil, grease and grit removal system at Agana WWTP to enhance overall operability.
- (6) Other works associated with the above scope as proposed or identified during the bidding process."
