AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF §4124 OF CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 17 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO SERVICE LEARNING AS A REQUIREMENT FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Subsection (b) of §4124 of Chapter 4 of Title 17 of the Guam
- 3 Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:
- 4 "(b) Beginning with the ninth (9th) grade class in the 2011-2012
- School Year, and for every school year thereafter, each student shall
- 6 complete seventy-five (75) hours of service learning as a requirement for

high school graduation. Service hours earned shall be printed on each report card. The Superintendent, with the approval of the Board, *shall* establish the minimum number of hours of service learning required by the end of the student's eleventh (11th) grade year in order to be promoted to senior status. The Superintendent, with the approval of the Board, *shall* establish the prorated number of hours of service learning for students transferring into the Guam Public School System from off-island, or from private schools, after the start of their sophomore year to be promoted to senior status and high school graduation."
