### AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11 OF PUBLIC LAW 30-101, RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE GUAM VETERANS AFFAIRS OFFICE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Section 11 of Public Law 30-101 is hereby *amended* to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "Section 11. A new Subsection (x)(3) of Section 1, Chapter V of
- 5 Public Law 30-55 is hereby *added* to read as follows:

"(3) Guam Veterans Cemetery Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) is reprogrammed from the Guam Highway Fund and appropriated to the Guam Veterans Affairs Office for the following use:

- (A) To purchase materials, supplies and equipment to sustain cemetery maintenance efforts for Fiscal Year 2010; and
- (B) To procure services to address the deficiencies which were identified in the August 2009 Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery Administration's Triennial Report on the Guam Veterans Cemetery."
- **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
